EXEMPLARY ACHIEVEMENTS IN ACADEMICS

Excellence in academics is the hallmark of any good institution and class X and XII results of our school prove without any doubt that our students have made us proud.

Of the 141 students who registered for the SSCE, 117 students secured distinction and 16 students secured A1 in all subjects. Aishwaria N scored 97.6% in Science stream and Madhurima S Rudra secured 98% in Commerce Stream and became the school toppers in Class 12. Of the 148 students registered for SSE, 131 students secured distinction and 26 of them secured A1 in all subjects. Nehal Sara scored 99% thereby becoming the school topper in Class 10..

This year we have 116 students appearing for the SSCE and 113 appearing for the SSE. We bestow our blessings upon them.

As per NEP 2020, latest pedagogical interventions like Toy Paedagogy, Joyful Learning and Storytelling as pedagogy have been introduced in the primary classes.

To improve the awareness, develop skills and make children industry-smart, skill development modules have been introduced in middle school. Modules on financial literacy are being transacted for students of Standard VI, VII and VIII and Artificial intelligence has been made a part of the curricular transaction in classes IX and X and this year it is introduced as the sixth optional subject in Std XI.

ORATORY CLUB

Oratory club, initiated by the Department of English, is a vibrant, creative and innovative public speaking forum which caters to providing students with a perfect environment to hone their speaking skills.

• Reduction of Bag Weight

A study on the factors affecting weight of the bag was conducted by the teachers. After an analysis of the findings, the following steps were taken

(i) Children were advised to bring empty water bottles and fill in water from the water dispensers at school.

(ii) A schedule was drawn in such a way that the children need not carry the textbooks to school daily.

INCLUSIVE EDUCATION FACILITY

We have around 50 children who come under CWSN from classes KG to Std VIII and three Educators in this department. These students attend the regular classes with their peers and get the required support from the teachers and remedial educators who are trained in special education.Our Health and wellness teacher provides all the support to children in need, especially post pandemic
