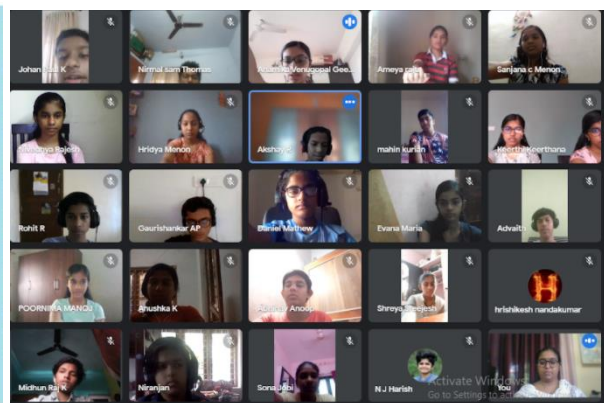


Students took Reading Pledge to cultivate reading habit

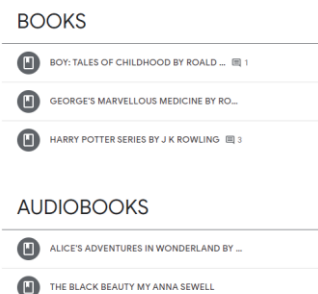
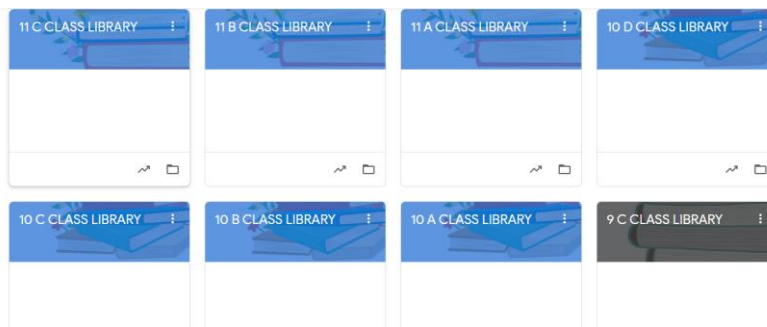
Mass Reading Programme was organised with a 15 minute reading material provided to each class.



A Padlet was created and provided to all students so as to write the Book Review of their favourite book.

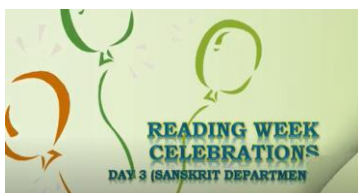


Inaugurated Virtual Classroom Library for each class. Books in pdf format is posted in the virtual library classroom fortnightly.
